Contest

PME MTL Centre-Ouest, one of the six areas of service of PME MTL, the Ville de Montréal's business support network, in collaboration with Desjardins, the Centre d'expertise industrielle de Montréal (CEI MTL), and the Réseau Mentorat Montréal, is launching an entrepreneurial contest called TechPreneur to support tomorrow's technology leaders.

The TechPreneur contest is intended primarily for young technology businesses that are looking to set up (or have already) on the Technoparc Montréal territory.



Why this contest?

The technology industry is booming in Quebec, and has grown even more due to the pandemic. But it is also an industry in demand where innovation is needed to keep local know-how and remain competitive.

This contest aims above all to support the leaders of tomorrow, young companies with great potential and to encourage several entrepreneurs through a grant and coaching, the means to develop, a community and a network of the most important in Quebec in the technology industry.



Estimated timetable

November 22, 2021 to January 31, 2022: Submission of applications

Mars 2022: Pre-selection of the 5 finalists*.

Mars 2022: Final selection of candidates

April 2022: Announcement of the winner(s)

The winning company will have until October 31, 2022 to set up shop in one of the two business centres of the Technoparc Montréal.

Please note that the dates of the competition may change in order to adapt to the ever-changing pandemic contextsituation.

^{*} The final selection will be made by a jury of professional experts.



Conditions for eligibility

- → Operate a technology company, i.e. a company that designs and/ or develops one or more technological solutions or services, which can be either electronic or digital.
- → Operate a company that has been in existence for less than five years
- Launch a legally constituted business listed in the Registre d'entreprises du Québec (REQ)
- → Commit to working full-time in the business (at least 35 hours per week)
- → Be located in or plan to set up in one of the two Technoparc Montréal business centres on October 31, 2022 at the latest
- → Submit all required documents before the contest deadline on January 31, 2022 at the latest



Required documents

- → Duly completed contest entry form (see below)
- → Business plan or summary (maximum 15 pages)
- → Financial forecast for the first 2 years of operation of the business
